New Business

Review of TIF Management Report

Darla Brown explained this is an Annual TIF Management Report prepared by Baker Tilly to be filed with the Indiana Department of Local Government Finance by tomorrow. Darla stated she emailed the report to the Town Council, and it is an agenda item for them. EDC members acknowledged receiving the report.

Discuss to Clarify TIF Parcel Numbers/Legal Descriptions

Darla Brown explained that the auditor found inconsistencies in parcel numbers and descriptions in the TIF. She and Denise are working through this and will submit it to the auditor and bring this information back to the board. Dr. Hash asked about adding additional TIF area that was not initially included. Mike Farmer stated it is worth exploring in the future.

William Ellis asked about the recent flooding and how it compared to past flooding and expressed concern over continuing to make improvements to encourage economic development.
