August 11, 2025

The Ellettsville, Indiana Town Council met for a regular meeting on Monday, August 11, 2025, at the Ellettsville Town Hall Meeting Room located at 1150 West Guy McCown Drive. Scott Oldham called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Chief Jimmie Durnil gave a word of prayer followed by the Pledge of Allegiance led by Chief Kevin Patton.

Roll Call: Members present were Scott Oldham – President, Trevor Sager, William Ellis and Dan Swafford. Pamela Samples was absent. Mike Farmer – Town Manager and Darla Brown – Town Attorney were also present. Denise Line served in place of Noelle Conyer, Clerk Treasurer who was absent.

Supervisors Participating: Kevin Patton – Fire Chief, Jimmie Durnil – Town Marshal, Kip Headdy - DWP Director and Denise Line – Planning Director.

Approval of the Minutes for the Regular meeting July 28, 2025

Scott Oldham entertained a motion for approval of the minutes of the regular meeting on July 28, 2025. William Ellis so moved. Trevor Sager seconded. All in favor, motion carries.

Accounts Payable Vouchers and Payroll

Scott Oldham entertained a motion to pay Accounts Payable Vouchers and Payroll. Trevor Sager so moved. William Ellis seconded. All in favor, motion carries.

Resolutions

Resolution 21-2025 Additional Appropriation Local Roads & Street

Kip Headdy, Street Commissioners explained this is money that needs moved into the Local Roads and Streets to pay for the community Crossings Matching Grant. All the streets have been paved and are in good shape and we are ready to pay the local contractor. The amount is \$244,215.10 on the paperwork if it is incorrect they can correct at the next meeting. Trevor Sager made a motion to approve Resolution 21-2025 Additional Appropriation Local Roads & Street. Dan Swafford seconded. Roll call vote: Scott Oldham – yes; Dan Swafford – yes; William Ellis – yes; Trevor Sager – yes. Motion carries.

Resolution 22-2025 accepting bid from Integrity Exteriors, LLC to replace Fire Station Roof

Darla Brown, Town Attorney discussed that at the last Town Council meeting there were 3 bids open for the Fire Department Roof. The lowest was from AMI Roofing for \$93,500, next was from Integrity Exterior's LLC for \$116,589.15. It is required by the Town when bids or quotes are requested they are required to accept the lowest and lowest responsible and responsive bidder and upon examination of the bids the Fire Chief determined that the lowest bid was not responsive to his request in four different ways. The bid did not include flashing along the roof line and did not include snow and ice guards, ice and water shields for the roof decking in the valley along the bay walls and roof openings or along the vents or flue pipes. The bid included a ridge vent at the peaks only. The purpose of this Resolution is to set forth the purpose that the Town might accept the next lowest bid from Integrity Exteriors for \$116,589.15. William Ellis made a motion to approve Resolution 22-2025 accepting bid from Integrity Exteriors, LLC to replace Fire Station Roof. Dan Swafford seconded. Roll call vote: Scott Oldham – yes; Dan Swafford – yes; William Ellis – yes; Trevor Sager – yes. Motion carries.

Ordinance on First Reading - None

Ordinance 2025-18 Imposing a Wheel Tax and Motor Vehicle License Excise Tax

Darla Brown, Town Attorney explained if the Town wants to get local road and bridge matching funds, you are going to be required to pass a wheel tax and you can't just pass a wheel tax you also have to pass the Motor Vehicle license excise surtax so you can pass it in one Ordinance or simultaneously. The purpose of this Ordinance is to establish a wheel tax fund and motor vehicle license excise surtax fund. Under Indiana Code, you have some choices and some leeway with regard to how much you can charge or want to charge. The wheel tax is for commercial vehicles and it is \$5-\$40. The motor vehicle license excise surtax is for passenger vehicles and it is \$7.50-\$25. She was asked to set the wheel tax at \$5 and municipal surtax at \$15 for a total of \$20. Paige Sansone from Baker Tilly calculated how much the town would make at \$ and \$15 and she estimated the town would earn just under \$90,000.00. Dan Swafford questioned if you still get charged from the county

and Darla confirmed that when you register your car every year at the BMV you would still get charged. He also had asked about when you pay the county wheel tax you are still eligible for the grant as long as you are paying this. Darla stated that Indiana Code 8-23-30-2 discusses the local road and bridge matching grant fund and at the end it says beginning on June 30, 2027 and on June 30th of each year thereafter, the state controller will make a transfer under subsection J and the state controller shall distribute the funds as follows. It further states to be eligible to receive a distribution a local unit must have adopted a wheel tax, adopted the local technical assistant program at Purdue University with an updated transportation asset management plan, which the town has and that is your Exhibit A, the Ordinance. It also states you cannot pass a wheel tax without passing the surtax. The confusion is whether we already adopted it at the county level but it is believed it has to be the local unit. Without this we cannot be eligible for grants and that is how we pave a lot of our streets and other things. Average amount is \$250,000.00. The only funds they could use are from a restricted line of about \$130,000.00 which will not go very far. Each year, if this adopted the BMV will collect the fees and has 21 days to distribute to the Town. The Town has to do an appropriation with a public hearing to use it. To be clear, it is stacked on top of the county tax. It can go as much as \$65.00 total but it was agreed to keep things as low as possible and do \$20.00. Scott Oldham offered some insight explaining that SB 1 was passed by the Indiana House Senate and signed by the governor where the state is going to drop your taxes and then it's going to tell the localities you have to raise the taxes, bait and switch for lack of better words. This is something we have to do or there will not be anything else because the State of Indiana has cut the money so much that we will have to reduce our personnel to the point where we just are not capable of doing some of the things we do currently like Firefighters, Policemen and snow removal. It will bankrupt several counties, cities or towns. This is just the tip of the iceberg so we are trying to be proactive and not push any more pain down the road than we have to. The State did not think this out and we are going to have to be the bad guys just to survive. It does not add a dime, it is about making back a little bit about what the state is going to take away. We will be lucky if we make it through the next 4 to 5 years without being so far behind that it is going to be almost impossible to grow to catch up. This is only the beginning. This will be available online and will be voted on at the next meeting.

Valerie Dewar, Chamber of Commerce Board member suggested getting together with the Council and help with public education on this issue because this not only affects private citizens it affects our businesses.

Supervisor Comments

Michael Farmer, Town Manager reminded everyone that before the next meeting there is a Work Session at 5:00 and invited the board to attend to understand the budget and what this Ordinance will bring to the next several years. Baker Tilly will do a presentation to explain not only where we are going to be next year but the next 2 following years and our budget is going to represent what we think needs to happen for 3 years. Board members can contact the Clerk's office for budget numbers.

Jimmie Durnil, Town Marshal advised there is some paperwork in the packet he needs signed for the parade permit.

Kevin Patton, Fire Chief thanked council for approving the roof repair, he would like to discuss where to get the funds. He would like to finance it for 3 years to spread the cost out and not deplete the Cumulative building and equipment fund. He uses that for repairing fire trucks, tires engines and things and if he pays the whole thing out of that fund it will all but zero it out. He will call tomorrow and get numbers and see it they can get it for 3 years and paying it over 2 if he can. That will give him some cushion.

Council Comments

Scott Oldham advised we need to revisit the mass gathering permit and get some public education on it.

Scott Oldham thanked everyone in the room and their predecessors that have stuck with the Town over the years and made many sacrifices, scrimped, cut and made do year after year and saved the Town from being bankrupt and now has a general fund that will hopefully get us through these weird times. He congratulated and thanked all from the council.

State Law Requirements

When pursuing an annexation, a municipality must comply with State law, as established in the statutes at I.C. 36-4-3 et seq., as amended. I.C. 36-4-3-1.5 sets forth the requirements for contiguity:

1. The aggregate external boundaries of the territory sought to be annexed are seventy-one percent (71%) contiguous to the boundaries of the municipality;

Additionally, Indiana Statute (IC 36-4-3-3.1) requires the Town of Ellettsville, the annexing municipality, to develop and adopt by resolution, a fiscal plan for extension of municipal services to the annexed area.

In the preparation of the annexation fiscal plan, as required by Indiana Code, the Town of Ellettsville has determined and compared the cost of providing non-capital and capital services to the annexation area, with the potential tax revenue generated by the developed parcel. The fiscal plan shall identify the following:

- 1. The cost estimates for planned services to be furnished to the property to be annexed;
- 2. The method or methods of financing the planned services;
- The organization and extension of services;
- 4. That planned services of a non-capital nature, including police protection, fire protection, street and road maintenance, and other non-capital services normally provided within the corporate boundaries will be provided within one (1) year after the effective date of annexation;

It is not intended to serve a specific budgetary purpose, but rather express estimated costs and benefits based on a set of level-of-service related assumptions.

Organization and Extension of Services

The Town of Ellettsville is committed to providing capital and non-capital services to the land proposed for annexation in the same manner as areas currently within Town limits, regardless of similarity. Non-capital services will be provided within one year of the completion of the annexation. Capital improvements, if any, will be provided within three years of the completion of the annexation. Any monetary figures presented here are merely estimates, subject to change. Many variables, including the rate and extent of future development, future property assessments, and fluctuations in the cost of providing various services are expected to have an influence.

1. Non-Capital Improvements:

The Town of Ellettsville Departments of Planning, Utilities, Stormwater, Police, Fire, EMS, Clerk/Treasurer, and Street will assume and retain immediate responsibility. There are little to no actual anticipated costs with the extension of these services and each of these services will be readily available within the one (1) year requirement.

2. Capital Improvements:

Capital improvements are those such as water, sanitary sewer, storm sewer and street maintenance projects that would be required for further development. Each of these utilities are currently located on or near the property and will not require any capital projects. Any new development of the property requiring utilities will be the responsibility of the developer. Other utilities such as natural gas, electric, cable, and telephone services are provided by private companies.

Financial Recommendations

The purpose of this section is to review and discuss the potential revenues for funding the increased costs for providing services to the annexation area.

1. Real Property Tax

a. The net assessed valuations of the parcel as of April 11, 2025, is \$145,800 and will have very little impact on the tax rate throughout town and will have little effect on revenue. See 'Effect of Annexation' section for further information.

2. Personal Property Tax

- a. There will likely not be personal property taxes associated with development of this parcel.
- Local Income Tax (LIT)
 - a. On July 1st of each year, the Indiana Department of Revenue certifies a distribution of the Local Income Tax (LIT) for Monroe County. LIT is distributed based upon the

proportionate share of the Town's budget levy in relation to the civil taxing units and school corporations within the county and is dependent on a number of variables including the budget levies of other taxing units in Monroe County and the estimated county income tax collection. The estimated LIT revenues to the Town attributable to the annexation cannot be determined.

4. Water/Sewer

a. There are no expected cost increases to the Town to provide these services.

Effect of Annexation

- 1. Estimated Effect on Taxpayers in Ellettsville
 - a. The estimated tax rate would increase from 0.5673 to 0.5645 in the year 2025 2026, and would be expected to remain relatively similar for the next four (4) years.
 - b. The estimated change in tax levy per taxpayer will be minimal. The tax rate drop of 0.056 would amount to approximately \$11.00 per year for a \$200,000 home. The amount over four (4) years would be negligible.

ORDINANCE 2025-18

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A MUNICIPAL WHEEL TAX AND MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE SURTAX AND CREATING THE TOWN OF ELLETTSVILLE WHEEL TAX FUND AND THE TOWN OF ELLETTSVILLE MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE EXCISE SURTAX FUND

WHEREAS, absent the adoption of this Ordinance, the Town of Ellettsville would not be eligible for local road and bridges matching grant funds; and

WHEREAS, Ind. Code § 6-3.5-11 *et seq.* (the "Wheel Tax Act") authorizes the Ellettsville Town Council to impose by ordinance an annual municipal wheel tax ("Wheel Tax") of not more than forty dollars (\$40.00) on certain motor vehicles registered within the Town of Ellettsville; and

WHEREAS, Ind. Code § 6-3.5-10 *et seq.* (the "Motor Vehicle License Excise Surtax") authorizes the Ellettsville Town Council to impose by ordinance an annual municipal vehicle excise tax (the "Excise Surtax") at a rate of not more than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) on certain vehicles registered within the Town of Ellettsville; and

WHEREAS, the Wheel Tax Act authorizes the Town Council to impose the Wheel Tax at a different rate for each class of vehicle subject to the Wheel Tax Act; and

WHEREAS, the Excise Tax authorize the Town Council to impose the Excise Surtax on each motor vehicle that is subject to the tax; and

WHEREAS, the Wheel Tax prohibits the Town Council from adopting an ordinance imposing a Wheel Tax unless the Town Council concurrently adopts an ordinance under Ind. Code § 6-3.5-10 *et seq.* to impose the Excise Tax; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Code § 6-3.5-10 *et seq*. the Town Council is concurrently adopting an Excise Surtax; and

WHEREAS, the Town utilizes a traffic asset management plan referred to as its pavement asset management plan, which has been approved by INDOT and is outlined in the attached Exhibit A, which is incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council deems it necessary to impose the Excise Surtax and the Wheel Tax so that it may generate revenue to support the safe operation and continued maintenance of streets and roads under the Town's jurisdiction.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Ellettsville, Monroe County, Indiana, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Ellettsville Town Code is hereby amended to create and add Section 33.93, "Wheel Tax and Fund", and Section 33.94, "Max and Fund," to Chapter 33, Finances and Records The new code sections shall read as follows:

Section 33.93 Wheel Tax and Fund

- (A) Definitions. The definitions and provisions set forth in Ind. Code § 6-3.5-11-1 are incorporated herein by reference and shall apply throughout this Ordinance.
- (B) Town of Ellettsville Wheel Tax Fund. The "Town of Ellettsville Wheel Tax Fund" is hereby created and shall be a non-reverting fund. The Town may only use the Wheel Tax Fund for the following purposes:
 - (1) to construct, reconstruct, repair or maintain streets and roads that are under the jurisdiction of the Town;
 - (2) as a contribution to an authority established under Ind. Code § 36-7-23;
 - (3) for the Town's contribution to obtain a grant from the local road and bridge matching grant fund under Ind. Code § 8-23-30; and
 - (4) any other allowable uses under Ind. Code § 6-3.5-11.
- (C) Imposition and Rate of Wheel Tax. Effective January 1, 2026, the following vehicles registered in the Town of Ellettsville and subject to the Wheel Tax shall incur a Wheel Tax in the amount of five dollars (\$5.00) pursuant to Ind. Code § 6-3.5-11 *et seq.*:
 - (1) Buses
 - (2) Recreational vehicles
 - (3) Semitrailers
 - (4) Trailers with a declared gross weight of more than nine thousand (9,000) pounds
 - (5) Trucks and tractors with a declared gross weight of more than eleven thousand (11,000) pounds.
- (D) Pursuant to Ind. Code § 6-3.5-11-4, a vehicle is exempt from the Wheel Tax if the vehicle is:
 - (1) owned by the State of Indiana;
 - (2) owned by a state agency of the State of Indiana;
 - (3) owned by a political subdivision of the State of Indiana;
 - (4) subject to the annual license excise surtax imposed pursuant to Ind. Code § 6-3.5-5-10
 - (5) a bus owned and operated by a religious or non-profit youth organization and used to transport persons to religious services or for the benefit of its members;
 - (6) a school bus;
 - (7) a motor vehicle that is funeral equipment and that is used in the operation of funeral services as defined by Ind. Code § 25-15-2-17; or
 - (8) any other vehicle exempt pursuant to Ind. Code § 6-3.5-11-4.

- (E) The Wheel Tax shall be paid to the Indiana Bureau of Motor Vehicles each year at the time the vehicle is registered. The Town's Clerk-Treasurer shall deposit the Wheel Tax revenues in a fund to be known as the "Town of Ellettsville Wheel Tax Fund" and shall distribute the Town of Ellettsville Wheel Tax Fund consistent with Ind. Code § 6-3.5-11-1 *et seq*.
- (F) Accounting of Wheel Tax Fund. On or before October 1st of each year, the Town Clerk-Treasurer shall provide the Town Council an estimate of the Wheel Tax revenues to be received by the Town during the next calendar year. The Town shall include the estimated Wheel Tax revenues in the Town's budget estimate for the calendar year.
- (G) Transmittal of Ordinance. The Town Council authorizes the Council President or his designee to provide a copy of this Ordinance to the Indiana Department of Revenue and the Indiana Bureau of Motor Vehicles as required by Ind. Code § 6-3.5-11-8.

Section 33.94 Municipal Surtax and Fund

- (A) Definitions. The definitions and provisions set forth in Ind. Code § 6-3.5-10-1 are incorporated herein by reference and shall apply throughout this Ordinance.
- (B) Town of Ellettsville Municipal Surtax Fund. The "Town of Ellettsville Municipal Surtax Fund" is hereby created and shall be a non-reverting fund. The Town may use the Surtax Fund revenues for the following purposes:
 - (1) to construct, reconstruct, repair or maintain streets and roads that are under the jurisdiction of the Town;
 - (2) for the Town's contribution to obtain a grant from the local road and bridge matching grant fund under Ind. Code § 8-23-30; and
 - (3) any other allowable uses under Ind. Code § 6-3.5-10.
- (C) Imposition and Rate of Excise Surtax. Effective January 1, 2026, the following vehicles registered in the Town of Ellettsville and subject to the Excise Surtax shall incur an Excise Surtax in the amount of fifteen dollars (\$15.00) pursuant to Ind. Code \$ 6-3.5-10 et seq.:
 - (1) Passenger Motor Vehicles
 - (2) Motorcycles
 - (3) Motor drive cycles
 - (4) Collector vehicles
 - (5) Trailer vehicles with a declared gross weight of 9,000 pounds or less
 - (6) Trucks with a declared gross weight of 11,000 pounds or less
 - (7) Mini-trucks
 - (8) Military vehicles

- (D) The Excise Surtax shall be paid with the registration of each vehicle each year. The Town's Clerk-Treasurer shall deposit revenue from the Excise Surtax in a fund to be known as the "Town of Ellettsville Municipal Surtax Fund" and shall distribute the Surtax Fund consistent with Ind. Code § 6-3.5-10-10.
- (E) Accounting of Excise Surtax Fund. On or before October 1st of each year, the Town Clerk-Treasurer shall provide the Town Council an estimate of the Excise Surtax revenues to be received by the Town during the next calendar year. The Town shall include the estimated Excise Surtax revenues in the Town's budget estimate for the calendar year.
- (F) Transmittal of Ordinance. The Town Council authorizes the Council President or his designee to provide a copy of this Ordinance to the Indiana Department of Revenue and the Indiana Bureau of Motor Vehicles as required by Ind. Code § 6-3.5-10-6.
- <u>Section 2</u>. The recitals are incorporated herein by reference.
- <u>Section 3</u>. All prior ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed. This Ordinance shall have no effect upon any other sections of the Ellettsville Town Code or ordinances not specifically changed by this Ordinance, except as herein provided, and all other sections of the Ellettsville Town Code not inconsistent herewith remain the same.
- <u>Section 4</u>. If any word, clause, phrase, sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality or unenforceability shall not affect any of the remaining words, clauses, phrases, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this Ordinance.
- <u>Section 5.</u> This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval, and publication according to law.
