### **Resolutions**

#### **Resolution 26-2025 to Declare Police Department Equipment as Surplus - As Amended**

**Darla Brown**, Town Attorney explained this Resolution was amended based on comments at the last Town council meeting. It is now a Resolution authorizing transfer of taser devices to the Indiana University Police Department (IUPD). Indiana Code permits the exchange of property between governmental bodies for any amount of property or cash as agreed upon by the governmental entities and upon each entity passing a similar Resolution. She contacted Lt. Wilson at the IUPD who is working with the IUPD council office to figure out who signs the Resolution. The Resolution has been modified to state the tasers are going to be donated to the IUPD. Dan Swafford made a motion to approve Resolution 26-25 to Declare Police Department Equipment as Surplus- As Amended. Pamela Samples seconded. Roll call vote: Scott Oldham – yes; Dan Swafford – yes; William Ellis – yes; Pamela Samples – yes. Motion passes.


